On January 29, 2010, a settlement agreement ("Agreement") was executed in the lawsuit styled *INX Inc. v. International Business Machines Corp.* ("IBM") for all outstanding litigation between the parties previously disclosed. This contract dispute was previously disclosed in the Form 10-K/A of INX Inc. ("INX") for the year ended December 31, 2008. The Agreement requires IBM to pay INX the amount of \$310,000 less legal fees of \$112,000 within 30 days, which will be recorded by INX in the first quarter of 2010 as a reduction of selling, general and administrative expenses.
